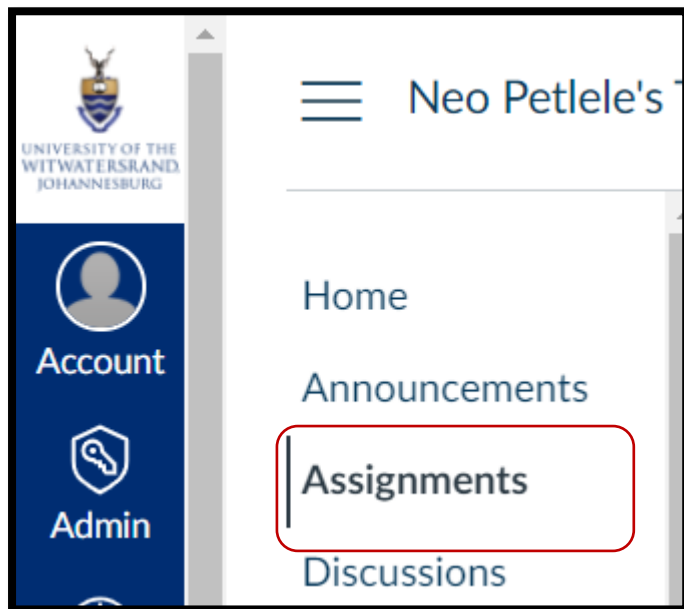
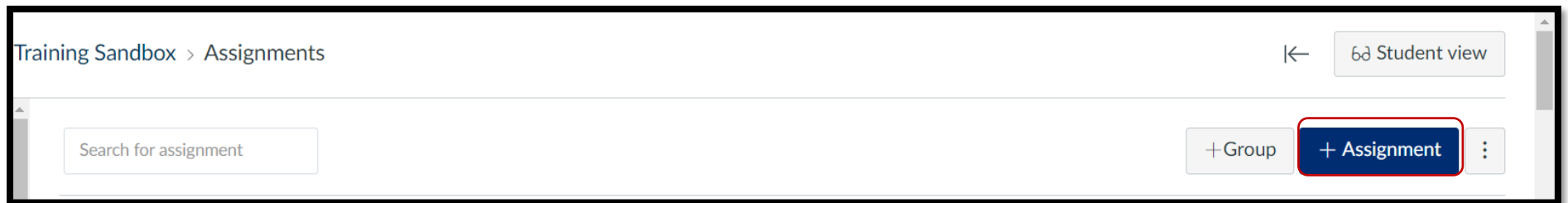


## How to embed a quiz in an assignment? ( Graded assessment )

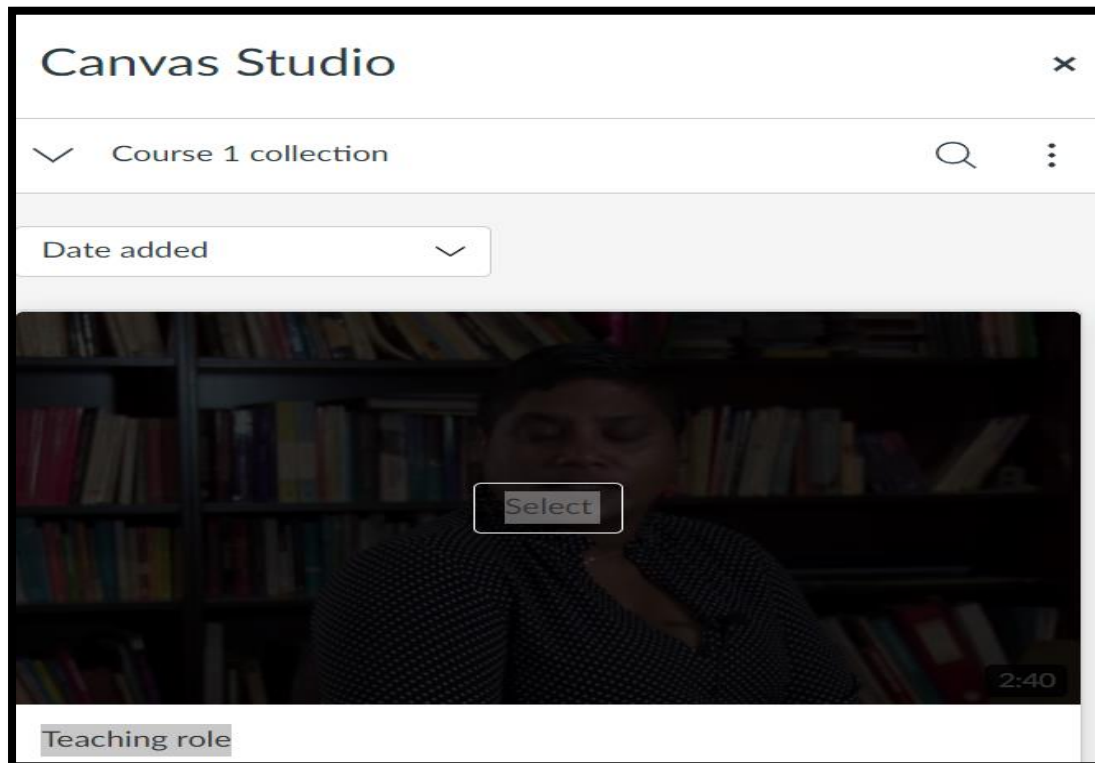

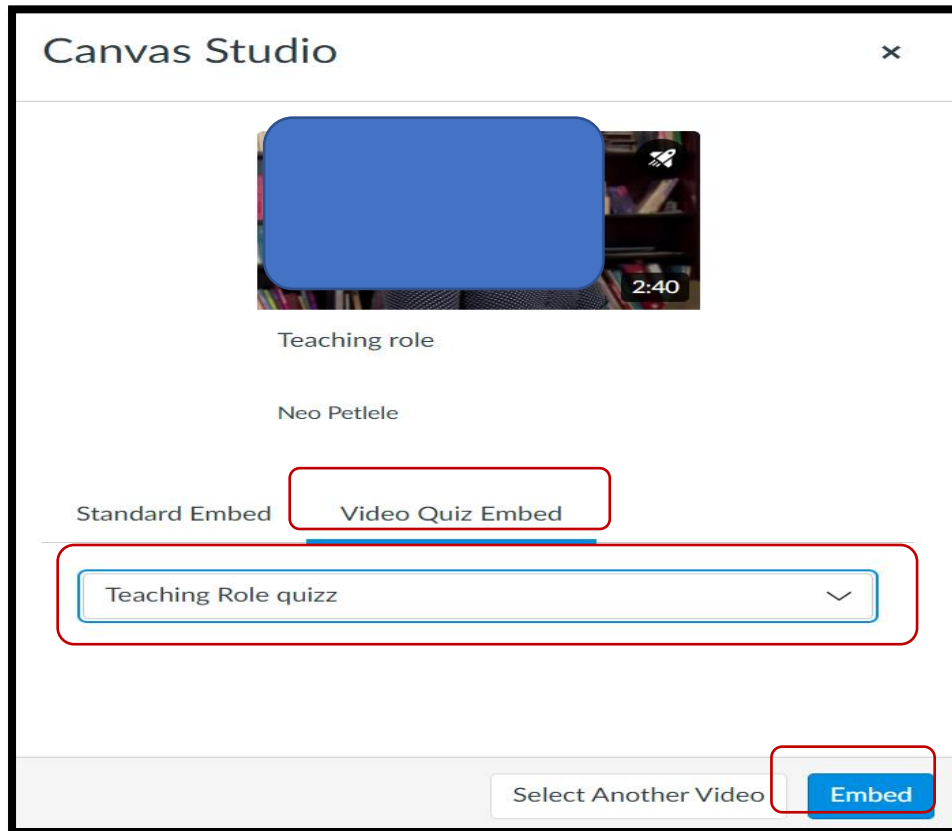


